FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESK



CHARITABLE DONATIONS - BOYCOTT EXPLAINED

Someone left us an anonymous message asking that DCRTL resolve our differences with the Alzheimer's Association. It grieves me when someone, upset with what we say or do, makes anonymous contact. The problem with an anonymous criticism is the fact that we can't explain our position. Our mission is to end abortion, infanticide and euthanasia through education. DCRTL believes that once one learns the truth about these issues, they will come out on the side of life. So, let me share our thinking with you.

Let's look at CHARITABLE GIVING. Everyone wants your money!!! But how do you pick the right charity? **First, to whom (exactly) are you giving?** Many organizations have similar sounding names. It's easy to confuse one with another. Ask questions. Become informed. Be sure you know who you are giving your money to and what exactly they do. Assess the degree of involvement with morally unacceptable practices. It's always a good idea to ask them to send some written information before you commit. **Next, how will your donation be spent?** Avoid activities which directly support or appear to directly support, morally impermissible activities. **From a pro-life perspective, this is most important. Just as we don't want our purchases to profit the abortion industry, we don't want our donations to benefit destruction of human beings, regardless of age or stage of development.** Many organizations support abortion, embryonic stem cell, and/or fetal tissue research. Don't support them.

Let's look at what DCRTL does. We send each organization requesting funds a letter. We ask for their policies on fetal tissue use, human embryo experimentation, embryonic and adult stem cell research, and cloning. In addition, we request their official position on abortion. We then evaluate the organization's involvement. Do they finance or participate in unethical research? If so, we suggest one way to actively work for change in the policies of the association is through withholding of donations. We believe that money speaks loudly and will effect change within an organization. Unethical research cannot continue without funding. Our rationale: We must not *directly or indirectly* support abortion by contributing to organizations which support abortion, embryonic or fetal tissue research. Anyone supporting this type of research is supporting the killing of human babies at various stages of growth and development. We believe that **THE END DOES NOT JUSTIFY THE MEANS.**

Do not get us wrong! We are in favor of research. We all have loved ones afflicted with various diseases with promised hope from stem cell research. We know how devastating these diseases can be. We, too, want a cure—or at least relief from manifestations of the diseases.

We also believe in the sanctity of all human life and that one life is not worth more than another. An interesting fact not often mentioned in the secular press is the successes gained using adult stem cells and lack of success using the embryonic cells.

We also know the unfortunate truth—that for most organizations, money speaks loudly and clearly. The bottom line is their focus. We can make a difference by “putting our money where our mouth is.” So here's the key, **don't just quit giving. Write to the organizations and tell them why.** If the organizations know they are losing money because of something they can change, chances are they'll make that change.

The Child Interstate Abortion Notification Act passed the House in 2005. Its companion , the **Child Custody Protection Act**, passed the Senate on July 25th. Because of differences in the two measures the bill must be referred to a joint House-Senate conference to develop a final version which would then have to be passed in both houses to go to the President's desk. At present, it is being held up in committee. The person to contact regarding this is Senator Harry Reid (1-202-224-3542).

The **Responsible Education About Life (REAL) Act** (S.368/HR2553) is supported by the National Abortion Rights Action League to establish the first-ever federal sex-education program.

The **Elizabeth Cady Stanton Pregnant and Parenting Student Services Act** (S.1966/H.R.4265) is being promoted by Feminists for Life to provide real alternatives to abortion for college students.

PLAN B NOW AVAILABLE OVER-THE-COUNTER

The **FDA's** recent decision to allow over-the-counter (OTC) status for Plan B (“**emergency contraception**”) for women is cause for concern. One can only believe that the decision was political* based on the facts and the number of unknowns involved. The stalled process of authorization suddenly moved forward when Senators threatened to hold up Dr. Andrew von Eschenbach’s confirmation as FDA director.

The supposed reduction in unintended pregnancies and abortions is not borne out in practice. Studies have shown that the availability of Plan B did not make any difference in abortion rates. In fact, abortion rates have risen to their highest levels ever in the UK which has had OTC status since 2001. The incidence of STD’s has also increased.

Without physician monitoring Plan B may be used repeatedly and frequently. The drug – levonorgestrel– is no different than the progesterone found in the regular birth control pill, which requires a doctor's prescription. It is however a much stronger dose (40 times stronger) according to Planned Parenthood’s website! [I was unable to find historical precedent for this action. There are drugs approved OTC in smaller doses than the prescription alternative. For example, Motrin 200mg is OTC, 800mg is prescription only.]

Potential risks to women’s health are considerable—in addition to the STDs and the consequences (infertility, cancers, etc.) women who do conceive have at least three times greater chance of an ectopic pregnancy. Its safety has not been tested on the younger teens. Granted, women must be 18 years old to purchase it. However, male sexual predators can easily obtain the drug. Adult men can buy the pills for underage partners. Finally, the FDA labeling states that the medication will not abort an implanted pregnancy but allows that it may stop implantation of a fertilized egg (embryo). This is obvious double-speak! While they are admitting the abortifacient action, they are doing it so that the uninformed will not quite get it. . . .so much for informed consent.

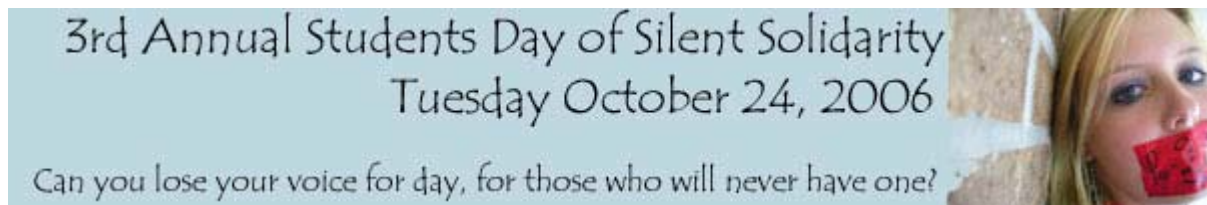
*Planned Parenthood’s ultimate goal is to have all birth control available OTC.

The Food & Drug Administration (**FDA**) has proposed a rule change that would allow medical experimentation on uninformed patients. The plan is regarding “**emergency research**” that scientists and doctors could conduct on unconscious or incapacitated patients. The proposed rules, known as “Guidance for Institutional Review Boards, Clinical Investigators, and Sponsors: Exception from Informed Consent for Emergency Research,” are scheduled for a public hearing next month. The proposal applies in situations where the patients are unconscious and cannot give consent and none of their representatives is available. Such “emergency research” could be conducted without any informed consent. Once again, the most helpless become the target! To voice your thoughts on this matter, contact your elected officials and the FDA (address above).

PRESIDENT BUSH VETOS STEM CELL RESEARCH BILL

When President Bush issued his very first veto this past July he took the opportunity to educate the public on life and death. He said that we can't go down the road of taking one life to save another but rather that science needs to resist the temptation to "manipulate human life and violate human dignity." Critics complain that this veto will somehow stop research. But the bill was about money, not what research can be done. He saved us, the American taxpayers, from having to fund unethical research, research that kill human beings in the earliest stages of development. Of course, that is good, but we must also continue to advocate for a total ban on any type of experimentation on human embryos and with it, a total ban on abortion.

The American Bar Association's Special Committee on Bioethics has appointed Estelle Rogers as Chairwoman. The American Life League reports that Ms. Rogers is the former executive director of the Death with Dignity National Center, a Washington-based organization dedicated to advancing assisted suicide. She has also held positions at the Planned Parenthood Federation of America, the Pro-Choice Public Education Project and the American Civil Liberties Union Reproductive Freedom Project. 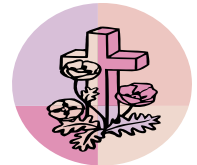
