## FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S DESK



### OCTOBER IS RESPECT LIFE MONTH!

We have been busy planning many activities and you are invited to all of them. Our calendar (see inside) is full so you should be able to find some way to participate. Details are provided throughout the newsletter. If you have questions after reading, feel free to call the office. And be sure to call to sign up for an hour of prayer on the 18th or to let us know you plan to “share your family.”

### SHROUDED IN SECRECY

A new Planned Parenthood (PP) building has just been constructed in Aurora, Illinois. It's never good news to hear that. But the interesting thing about it is that no one knew it was under construction. Well, they knew construction was being done at that address, but the sign on site indicated it was the “future home of Gemini Health Systems.” Apparently PP expected opposition and devised a plan of secrecy and deception. PP formed a limited partnership named Gemini Office Development, LLC and purchased the land & applied for all permits using that name. During the later stages of construction, one of the workers became suspicious when they were using bullet-proof glass and one room was referred to as a “recovery room.” He shared his concerns, a local pro-life group was alerted and a brief investigation done. PP leaders admitted that it was their facility and that they plan to commit abortions there.

The building is scheduled to open on September 18th (before you receive this newsletter) but area pro-lifers are doing all they can to either stop its opening or ensure it has a short stay if it does open. Since learning the true nature of the building pro-life leaders have organized a 24 hour/day prayer vigil at the facility, a prayer rally that drew 1200 individuals, an assembly of 120 to speak at the City Council meeting, and induced the city to hire a lawyer review the process PP used to make sure laws were followed.

This is not the first time PP has snuck into a community. In Portland, OR they tried to hide involvement with a new abortion mill by having a group called “Beach Street Partners” buy the property and build the building. They purchased land under a different name about a year ago in northeast Denver, CO. They plan to build an abortion facility and a regional center there. Construction is to begin this November with a projected occupancy date of August 2008. Pro-life groups in Denver are planning to be present at the site and may try to persuade contractors and construction workers to boycott participating in the building process.

These events are a clear indication that pro-lifers have been effective in their fight against PP. Why else would PP be afraid to let the public know when it plans to enter a new community? But, we can't rest on our laurels. We must be ever vigilant in our own community. If we hear of a health related structure planned or being built, we must investigate very carefully to make sure PP isn't involved. Remain alert and watchful. If it happened in Illinois, Colorado & Oregon it can happen anywhere.

**Please join our Action Alert List—We are currently setting up a database so we can notify you by email if there are any Pro-Life issues that you need to be aware of. Often we hear of legislative actions at the last minute and could then get the information out to you so we don't miss an opportunity to influence or at least let our views be heard. In addition to setting up an action alert database, we are exploring the possibility of distributing our newsletter via email or by notification that it is up on our website to anyone preferring that to the regular mail. 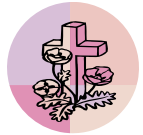
## Pro-life Memorial Day Service October 1

This year there will be memorial crosses along the route to signify the babies lost during the hour we are assembled. Every hour in the United States 180 babies die from surgical abortion.

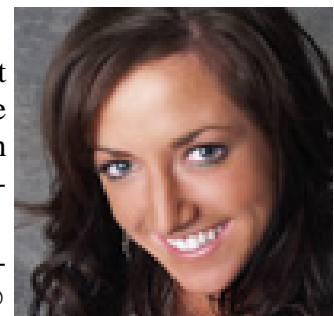

**BOYCOTT UPDATE:** According to Doug Scott, President of Life Decisions International, at least 153 corporations have ceased funding Planned Parenthood since they began the Corporate Funding Project 15 years ago. But that statement was made last July and 2 companies (Allstate-insurance and Wawa, Inc.-convenience stores), new to the list just published in July, are already off it. That means, they have agreed to stop funding PP in the short time since it was published! The following list of corporations appear for the first time: **DuPont** (chemicals), contact Mr. Charles O. The new Boycott List includes a revised and significantly expanded "Dishonorable Mention" section, which identifies **charitable organizations** that are associated with Planned Parenthood and/or its agenda. As non-profits, they are not boycott targets per se, but pro-life advocates should be aware of their activities. Among the groups new to this section is the **American Diabetes Association, Glaucoma Research Foundation, Juvenile Diabetes Foundation, Leukemia & Lymphoma Society, Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA), National Multiple Sclerosis Society**, among others.

**IMMEDIATE ACTION IS NEEDED.** Please call your Senators and Representatives (CAPITOL SWITCHBOARD 202/224-3121) and tell them you do not want your tax dollars spent on abortion or embryonic stem cell research: that is, they should restore the Smith Amendment, the Mexico City Policy, Kemp/Kasten and back ethical adult stem cell research.

Here's the background information. The appropriations bills set out the spending plan for the next fiscal year which begins October 1. In **HR-2829** the Financial Services Appropriation bill, the Senate has dropped the Smith Amendment which protects taxpayers from subsidizing abortions through the employer contribution to the Federal Employee Health Benefits Plan. In **HR-2764**, the State/Foreign Operations Appropriation measure, the Senate committee has adopted language undermining the "Mexico City" policy which restricts funding from foreign grantees involved with abortion or abortion lobbying. The "Kemp/Kasten Amendment" which bars funding to agencies like the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) for their support and/or participation in programs of coercive abortion or involuntary sterilization has been retained. In **S-1710**, the Labor/Health & Human Services Appropriation proposal has come out of committee providing tax funding for embryo-killing experiments. The measure, part of a \$34 billion foreign aid appropriations bill (H.R. 2764), must now be approved by both the House and the Senate in a final bill negotiated between the two houses. The good news is that President Bush has said he would veto "*any legislation that weakens current Federal policies and laws on abortion, or that encourages the destruction of human life at any stage.*" Please thank President Bush (WHITE HOUSE COMMENT LINE 202/456-1111 or [president@whitehouse.gov](mailto:president@whitehouse.gov)) for his decision to veto any provision that weakens Federal policies and laws on abortion.

### Two versions of SCHIP

The House of Representatives and Senate each passed their own version of a bill to reauthorize the federal government's State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP). The **House version** (HR-3162;HR-976) changes the 1997 SCHIP program so it no longer covers the child in the womb, but rather the "pregnant woman." It contains language that forces States to cover "family planning" (read-Planned Parenthood) services as part of their Medicaid programs and could possibly allow funding for abortions. While it increases funding for SCHIP by \$50 million, it contains a provision to remove funding for the Title V abstinence-only education program. In addition, language was added that would coerce rationing of lifesaving medical treatment. The **Senate version** (S-1893) is neutral as passed; the Allard Amendment which attempted to include unborn children again failed by 50-49 vote. The Senate could still adopt an amendment that mandates health care rationing. Health care rationing easily leads to withdrawal of lifesaving medical treatment and euthanasia. The bill now goes to a conference committee which meets later this month to iron out differences in the two pieces of legislation.

**ACTION:** Ask both your Senators & Representatives to amend any government-funded health care proposal so that it protects babies who might be killed by a "free" abortion AND protects taxpayers from being coerced into paying for any abortions. Let them know that denial of lifesaving medical treatment against the will of the patient is a form of involuntary euthanasia and we expect protection from that, too.

### OTHER LEGISLATION TO WATCH:

The following bills remain in committee but bear watching because they are being promoted as pro-life (decreasing unintended pregnancy and need for abortion) when in fact they promote contraception and increase taxpayer funding of "family planning" programs.

- Reducing the Need for Abortions and Supporting Parents Act (HR 1074)
- The Prevention First Act (S.21; HR 819)
- Responsible Education About Life Act –(S972 & HR 1653)
- Ensuring Access to Contraceptives Act (HR 2367)

Last July, funding for **Abstinence Only** Sex Education programs was extended through September only. We must keep vigilant in our efforts to keep these funds viable for the next fiscal year. Planned Parenthood lists several victories in the last few months. The top federal programs funding PP are the Social Security Act Medicaid reimbursements (Title XIX), HHS family planning program (Title X), Social Security Act Social Services Block Grant (Title XX) & Social Security Act Maternal & Child Services Block Grant (Title V).

Representative Chris Smith has re-introduced the **Unborn Child Pain Awareness Bill** (HR 3442). This legislation would expand and strengthen informed consent requirements prior to abortion.

Senators Sam Brownback and Edward Kennedy reintroduced the **Prenatally and Postnatally Diagnosed Conditions Awareness Act** (PPDCAA). The PPDCAA, which is an amendment to the Public Health Service Act, would ensure that care is offered during pregnancy and for the first year following the child's birth. Senator Brownback stated, "*When a mother receives the news that her unborn child may be born with a disability, she should be supplied with current and reliable information about the many options available for caring for children with disabilities.*"
