



Meal of Death Leaves Mothers and Children Victims to Abuse

What began as a simple drink from a coffee shop ended with a dead baby and a grieving mother. What happened in between was a man with ill-intentions towards his girlfriend and pre-born child.

Secretly adding abortion-inducing drugs in his girlfriend's drink, a Texas man by the name of Justin Anthony Banta killed his child against his girlfriend's expressed wishes to keep the baby. Banta, an IT man for the U.S. Department of Justice, is also suspected for deleting evidence related to the case.

Banta faces charges of capital murder and tampering of evidence.

This woman unknowingly drank pills that starved her child to death. She and her child are not the only victims to this meal of death. Just recently, a doctor from Toledo, OH had his medical license suspended for forcing a crushed abortion pill into the mouth of his girlfriend. And more and more stories like these keep surfacing in the news.

All because the abortion industry has made it easier than ever to access these harmful pills. With a few online searches, anyone can order abortion pills, often without ever seeing a medical professional.

If the industry truly cares about women, why do they advertise the abortion pill as safe? Why do some abortion pill providers celebrate the drug as "care" women can receive from the "comfort of their own home"?

There is nothing comforting about women delivering -- and then seeing -- their dead baby in their toilet. There is nothing "safe" about people with malicious intent secretly drugging women with the pills and killing an innocent human being.

And what is to stop abusers and rapists from ordering these pills and forcing them onto their victims to cover up their crime?

As the abortion industry hides behind lies and fake claims of compassion, we need to expose the abortion pill for what it is -- a dangerous drug that kills an innocent human being and leaves women vulnerable to abuse.

Abortion providers remain silent on the harm these pills inflict, and they want us to remain quiet, too. I encourage you to research these cases of abuse above, as well as to check out a recent study conducted by the Ethics and Public Policy Center. They found that serious adverse effects of the abortion pills are at least 22 times as high as what the drug label itself reports.

Let us take courage and speak up for these voiceless victims. The best way to combat these lies is to know the truth -- and share it. Moms and their babies are depending on us to reveal the darkness of these drugs, the sole intent of which is to kill.

One example of this was that we recently had two high school students from West Delaware high school do a written interview with our staff regarding our position on abortion as part of an assignment for an English class exploring both sides of the controversial issue.

These students were able to learn about the pro-life position, thanks to you. Without our supporters, both long-time and new, these young high school students and so many other people would not have encountered the pro-life message.

In this season of gratitude, thank you!

One of the key themes from 2025 is learning from what works. We have been blessed by other organizations like Protect Life Michigan, Canadian Centre for Bio-Ethical Reform, and Equal Rights Institute, who are seeing real results changing hearts and minds on campuses and in cities across North America.

These organizations are training young people to speak with both clarity and kindness on the issue of abortion. They have changed the culture of campuses and are changing public opinion on the issue of abortion.

Forming young advocates - the future of the pro-life movement

In order for cultural transformation to be longstanding, we must equip the future generations of our movement to be pro-life advocates.

That's why you've helped build things like our Generations for Life Summer Camp and Ambassadors for Life. These are programs where teens and young adults learn how to defend their pro-life convictions and then go put them into action by dialoguing with people in the community.

When you support this work, you are not only protecting our pre-born brothers and sisters right now, you are raising up the voices who will defend them for decades to come.

Increase in Outreach

In 2025, we increased our conversational outreach. As some of you may recall, we made some changes to our official County Fair booth sharing the truth of how abortion is violence by utilizing videos created by the pro-life group Live Action. This was impactful... Dozens of people who believed that abortion should be legal, changed their minds after seeing the video. If someone was pro-life, they became even more convicted of their beliefs. Other people who were pro-choice would become more uncomfortable with their stance.

Most of the people watching the video were young people. We heard statements following their watching of the video like "I would never have an abortion" "I didn't know it was so violent" "that's horrible" and "I don't think that should be allowed."

Thanks to the great organizations mentioned above and your generous support of building a pro-life culture locally, we have been able to increase our outreach and effectiveness.

Our focus for 2026

With God's help, and your partnership, in 2026 we want to continue to recruit and train the young people to build a sustainable high energy movement, to grow our Ambassadors for Life in number and effectiveness, and to move our door-to-door outreach and other forms of outreach from the pilot phase into a full part of what we do on a regular basis.

As we look back on 2025 and look forward to 2026, I'm very aware that none of this happens without you.

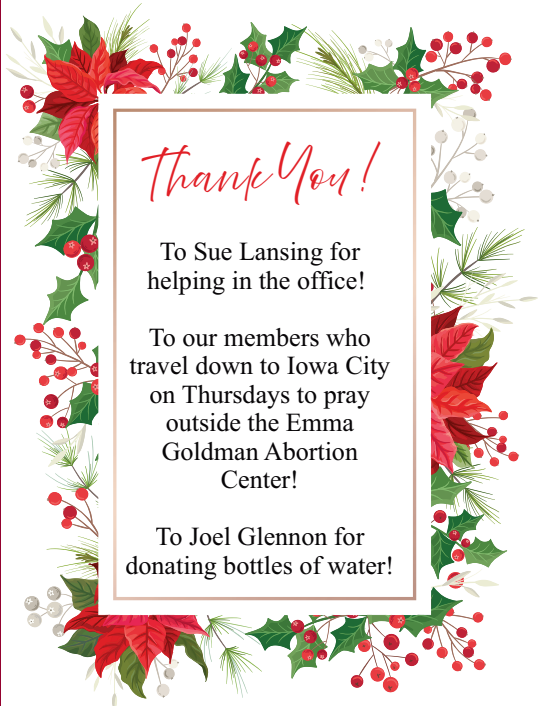

PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

Dear Friends for Life-

I have court and legislative news from several of our neighboring states.

Nebraska Governor Jim Pillen signed an executive order on October 30, 2025, stopping Planned Parenthood from receiving any Medicaid dollars through Nebraska's Medicaid program. This comes on the heels of Nebraska's other recent pro-life legislative measures, including 2023's Bill 574, which protects Nebraska babies after 12 weeks, mandates parental consent for minors considering abortion, and provides for a 24-hour waiting period before the abortion can be performed in case the mother changes her mind. The Nebraska legislature and governor know that women deserve better than abortion, and Unborn children have civil rights.

Our pro-life friends in Missouri have a real battle on their hands. You recall Missouri successfully passed a series of pro-life laws in recent years, but in November 2024, a majority of Missouri voters passed Constitutional Amendment #3, which enshrined the so-called "right" to abortion in the state's constitution. Since that time, pro-life efforts have concentrated on maintaining safety standards for women who are victimized by the abortion industry. These standards included things like a 72-hour waiting period, informed consent regarding the dangers of abortion, and mandating that abortionists have admitting privileges at nearby hospitals. However, abortions are currently legal in Missouri. Court fights regarding the standards are making their way to the Missouri Supreme Court. Also, there will be a ballot initiative in Missouri in November 2026, seeking to amend and/or repeal the pro-abortion Amendment #3 passed in 2024. We will keep you informed.

Now on to Illinois. Although there are many, many pro-life people there, the Illinois legislature passed SB 1950 on October 31, 2025. The Illinois House passed the same bill in May 2025. It is known as the "End-of-Life Options for Terminally Ill Patients Act." Governor Pritzker has 60 days to either sign it, veto it, or allow it to become law without his signature by taking no action either way. (As of this writing he has taken no action. When you receive this newsletter, Google "Pritzker and suicide legislation," and you'll be able to keep track of its status.) Make no mistake, this is quite simply suicide with the help of a doctor who writes a prescription for it. This anti-life bill declares the following:

"MEDICAL AID IN DYING IS PART OF GENERAL MEDICAL CARE AND COMPLIMENTS OTHER END-OF-LIFE OPTIONS, SUCH AS COMFORT CARE, PAIN CONTROL, PALLIATIVE CARE, AND HOSPICE CARE, FOR INDIVIDUALS TO HAVE AN END-OF-LIFE EXPERIENCE ALIGNED WITH THEIR BELIEFS AND VALUES."

Elderly and disability rights organizations are firmly against physician-assisted suicide. They correctly fear that pressure will be applied to the disabled and elderly to seek it out. Moreover, the American Medical Association opposes physician-assisted suicide. Its code of ethics states the following:

"IT IS UNDERSTANDABLE, THOUGH TRAGIC, THAT SOME PATIENTS IN EXTREME DURESS—SUCH AS THOSE SUFFERING FROM A TERMINAL, PAINFUL, DEBILITATING ILLNESS—MAY COME TO DECIDE THAT DEATH IS PREFERABLE TO LIFE. HOWEVER, PERMITTING PHYSICIANS TO ENGAGE IN ASSISTED SUICIDE WOULD ULTIMATELY CAUSE MORE HARM THAN GOOD... PHYSICIAN-ASSISTED SUICIDE IS FUNDAMENTALLY INCOMPATIBLE WITH A PHYSICIAN'S ROLE AS HEALER, WOULD BE DIFFICULT OR IMPOSSIBLE TO CONTROL, AND WOULD POSE SERIOUS SOCIETAL RISKS."

This type of legislation is introduced in Iowa every year by anti-life legislators. We expect it to be introduced again in the 2026 legislative session. There are currently no federal laws regarding doctor-assisted suicide. Therefore, it is up to each state to determine whether it wants assisted suicide.
