## A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

In December 1938, at the age of 29, Nicholas Winton was living the ideal young adult life. A London stockbroker with a good job, good friends, and a planned ski vacation in the beautiful Swiss Alps.

Then a friend, Martin Blake, urged him to cancel his trip and go to Prague instead. Refugees were pouring in following the Nazi invasion of the Sudetenland, a German-speaking region on the border of Czechoslovakia.

Nicholas went. *And what he saw there changed his life.*

He walked through the camps where Jewish families from Czechoslovakia were living in temporary makeshift shelters.

Vulnerable adults were in the process of being evacuated, but no one was yet working to get the children out before a Nazi invasion. So Nicholas decided he would.

Within weeks he returned to London, but what he saw while in Prague stuck with him. He worked his day job at the Stock Exchange, and as soon as work ended, he poured himself into rescuing these children late into the night.

He obtained permission from the British government for children to enter the country, as long as they had a foster family and a financial guarantee.

Nicholas, and a small group of others, including his own mom, found families, raised funds, and spent countless hours on passports and travel documents.

Just nine months later, on September 1, 1939, his efforts would be stopped with the beginning of the war. But not before Nicholas and his small team helped transfer 669 children to safety in the UK.

And then...decades passed. From those 669 children's lives saved, it has allowed over 15,000 people in future generations from children to great-grandchildren to be given the gift of life.

These children and the families they later formed were only possible because Nicholas Winton gave up a ski trip and answered a cry for help... even when the children themselves didn't know their lives were being saved at the time.

### **A new initiative you have heard about**

You may have seen the letter we recently sent regarding the Tri-state Human Rights Initiative project. This is a major undertaking where we will form 5-10 young adults, as they give up their plans this summer, to be bold advocates for the pro-life cause.

This program is only possible with your support.

We spent two weeks of the summer this year seeing a similar program implemented in Michigan. We want to bring that program to Dubuque to save the lives of the little children at risk of abortion, help their moms, and ultimately make strides toward our goal of making abortion unthinkable in our area.

### **Where we are now and how you can help**

Thanks to our generous donors, we have raised \$125,000 toward our goal to raise \$200,000 by January 30th.

## PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

Dear Friends for Life-

As usual, I have critical legislative news.

The wave sweeping the country allowing doctor-assisted suicide has engulfed 2 more states: Illinois and New York.

As reported in last month's column, the Illinois legislature recently passed the "End-of-Life Options for Terminally Ill Patients Act." Governor Pritzker signed it into law on Friday, December 12th, making Illinois the 12th state to legalize a doctor-killing suicide law. Make no mistake, this is quite simply suicide with the help of a doctor who writes a prescription for it. The interesting thing is that the patient who requests the death pill must be able to self-administer it! That presents a problem for the pro-euthanasia folks.

The Illinois law states:

***"Self-administer" means "an affirmative, conscious, voluntary action, performed by a qualified patient, to ingest medication prescribed pursuant to this Act to bring about the patient's peaceful death. "Self-administer" does not include administration by parenteral injection or infusion."***

New York also has passed a doctor-assisted suicide law. It is called the "Medical Aid in Dying Act." Governor Kathy Hochul announced on December 18th that she will sign it. All the same arguments against her approving the law were made by our pro-life colleagues in New York. By the time you read this news column, she will likely have acted on the bill, so google it at "Hochul right to die law" and watch for an email blast from our DCRTL office staff (Naomi or Molly) for an update.

Illinois and New York's laws only allow doctors to help patients die who are terminal. However, be warned that the requirement that patients themselves take the death pills on their own without help will soon be gone. This is because some patients won't be able to take the pills on their own due to physical limitations. Others will complain that oral medication is too expensive or ineffective. Illinois and New York will move quickly to death by a doctor who injects them. The patient will no longer need to take death pills themselves if they cannot physically do it. Indeed, a study of doctor-assisted suicide by Hamline (Minnesota) School of Law professor Thadeus Pope was cited in a report by The National Academy of Sciences in 2018 as follows:

***"Another area where the current U.S. state laws may be too strict, said Pope, is their requirement for self-administration of the lethal medication. This requirement is designed to help assure voluntariness, Pope explained, but some individuals lose the ability to self-ingest the medication. In addition, some people have complications from self-ingestion, as shown by the 3 to 6 percent complication rate noted in the latest data from Oregon (Oregon Health Authority, 2018). Pope added that the complication rate may rise as the practice moves away from using secobarbital to newer medications that do not have the same track record (Oregon Health Authority, 2018). Belgium, Canada, Luxembourg, and the Netherlands avoid this potential problem by allowing clinicians to administer lethal medications. Victoria's new law allows physician administration, but only in the case where a patient is physically incapable of self-administration or digestion."***

Thus, once you allow a doctor to help a person kill themselves, it logically follows that the doctor should be allowed to directly kill his or her patient if the patient cannot physically do it themselves. Moreover, if the logic behind these laws is to end suffering for the patient, it follows that people with prolonged but non-terminal illnesses should have the same right to kill themselves. Think of people with incurable cancer, lupus, or severe arthritis who are not expected to die within 6 months. Austria, Germany, Belgium, the Netherlands, and Spain all allow such non-terminal patients to commit suicide!!

That is where all assisted suicide laws go, so we need to stop them now. Remember, the American Medical Association opposes physician-assisted suicide, as does the Chicago Tribune Editorial Board, and millions of pro-life Americans.

Doctor-assisted suicide is currently illegal in Iowa, as it should be in every pro-life state. However, we expect doctor-assisted and suicide laws to be introduced again in the 2026 Iowa legislative session. There are currently no federal laws regarding doctor-assisted suicide. Therefore, it is up to each state to determine whether it wants assisted suicide. You will be called upon to voice your pro-life opinion at some point in the future, so stay vigilant, informed, and be ready to act.

Well, that's it for this month. Please watch for news of all of this in the Press, on TV, and on social media. DCRTL will keep you informed so you can express your pro-life views regarding these matters whenever and wherever possible.

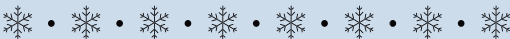
## 2026 Scholarship Contest

**Who:** Graduating high school seniors who plan to attend college.

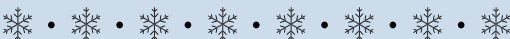
**Scholarship Amount:** Up to \$10,000 is available to be awarded between applicants at the discretion of the judging committee.

Dear Friends for Life,

Often today we see an uprising of Pro-Life advocates who solely rely on the consumers and followers within the realm of social media. Our goal as an organization is to utilize these platforms by bringing the Pro-Life message to those who may have never heard it before. Through the use of social media, we also reach the younger generation: The future of the Pro-Life movement.

So how can you become an effective partner? First, **follow us on our social media platforms** (listed below). The higher number of followers we have, the more relevant we become. Second, **increase engagement by liking, commenting, and sharing our posts**. This is probably the best way to intrigue others who may not have heard of our organization prior. Non-followers are more likely to comment on a post if there are already likes and comments on it. We want the most engagement possible because when that happens, conversations occur, and our mission in advocating for the pre-born is attained. And that's it! It may not seem like it, but when you become active on our social media accounts like our Instagram, Facebook, and Threads, (and now TikTok too!) you become an integral part in the Pro-Life movement.

When I joined DCRTL, I had a mission to improve our numbers on social media. Since I've joined, total views and reach have increased exponentially. On Instagram alone, our reach has increased by a little over 510%! Now if I've lost you here, hear me out. "Reach" refers to how many times a unique account has seen the content. So, if one person sees a post 5 times, it still counts as a 1 reach. "Views" are how many times total a post has been looked at, no matter if it is the same person or not. So really, reach is far more important than views because it means we are reaching people who have never seen our content before, and therefore further spreading the Pro-Life message.

Since I've joined, our content interaction has increased by 22.8% on Facebook and 100% on Instagram! Along with this, our visits to social media pages and follower count have also gone up. It is my personal goal to continue this trend and increase our online awareness. In doing this, we not only set an example but also help to shed the light on the tragedy of abortion, hoping to change hearts and minds. So for the takeaway, all YOU have to do as a fellow member of DCRTL is give us a follow and like, comment, and share our content. As a result, you are helping us achieve our goal and giving a voice to the pre-born.
