A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

In January 2026, Indiana Hoosiers finished a perfect season with a college football championship. The team with the most losses in college football history has just won the college football championship. At the beginning of the 2025 season, Indiana had zero five-star recruits and hadn't won against a ranked opponent since 2020. This past season would prove to be a different story, as they completed an undefeated season that included the championship and wins over big football giants like Ohio State and Alabama.

Indiana Hoosiers and the Pro-Life Movement

On the Dr. Phil podcast from February 4th, Dr. Phil shared some lessons we can learn from the Indiana Hoosiers turning a losing football program around and bringing home the championship. These lessons apply to our movement and successfully ending abortion, even when faced against Planned Parenthood and Big Abortion money.

The Lesson of Belief - Do you believe it is possible to make abortion unthinkable?

You have to sincerely believe that you can win a championship. Though they were underdogs, the Indiana Hoosiers believed they could win against top programs.

PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

Dear Friends for Life-

Let's focus on Iowa. Lots going on in the Iowa legislature with several pro-life bills being proposed.

House File (HF) 2563 proposes a law to address online black market abortion pills. It is generally agreed that most abortions done today are via abortion pills. Some are prescribed to pregnant women in crisis by abortionists who are doctors, but there is a large online world where women who are pregnant and need help receive abortion pills in the mail without ever seeing a doctor in person, without receiving any kind of physical examination, and without knowing the dangers of these death drugs. HF 2563 aims to protect these women and their babies from these death profiteers.

This proposed law requires these pills be dispensed only by an Iowa medical professional or licensed physician in Iowa. That doctor must conduct a physical examination in person. They must inform the pregnant woman of all the risks that taking these pills entail, including but not limited to excessive bleeding/hemorrhaging, sepsis, sterility, and the fact that "women using abortion-inducing drugs have suffered trauma from seeing the remains of the unborn child in the process of a chemical abortion." The law would also require that the doctor inform the women that, even if they take the first pill, the chemical abortion process can be reversed! She would be told that abortion pill reversal information is available on the Iowa Department of Health and Human Services. The woman would also be warned that she could suffer pulmonary embolism, cardiac arrest, respiratory arrest, renal failure, shock, and going into a coma. She would be warned of these things because all of them are known potential adverse effects of abortion pills. The woman would receive all this information in writing and confirm by her signature that she has been advised of all these harmful things that can happen to her if she takes these pills.

Doctors or anyone else who violate these rules could have their licenses revoked. In other words, the abortion pill salespeople from New York and other states would be put out of business in Iowa. Lastly, a pregnant woman could not be prosecuted civilly or criminally under this law. She is considered to be a victim and rightly so under the law. Women in these circumstances need help, and they deserve better than abortion.

All of the usual pro-death lobbyists you would expect have registered against this bill, including the ACLU and Planned Parenthood. Of note, the Iowa League of Women Voters has also registered against this bill. Why would anyone be against giving accurate health information to women considering abortion, especially in a situation where they are expected to abort their child into the toilet at home or in a hotel room?

As Iowa law does not currently allow us to totally stop abortion and truly help women facing unintended pregnancies, we need laws like HF 2563 to help and protect women and their unborn children from these black market abortion profiteers who prey upon them. These profiteers are violating women's civil rights.

A bill to provide a tax credit of up to \$5000 to individuals and businesses who donate to a maternity home in Iowa is pending in the Senate as SF 2279. This is a tremendous law that would spur more Iowans to give money to maternity homes like Mary's Inn right here in Dubuque. There are numerous maternity homes across Iowa, and who could be against such a provision in the law? Notably, as of February 16, 2026, not a single lobbyist had registered against this bill. That's good news, but our legislators still need to hear from you.

MARCHING FOR LIFE: INJUSTICE DEMANDS A RESPONSE

My experience attending the March for Life this year was vastly different from my first and only other March I attended in 2020.

That first year I marched, I did so with excitement, energy, and a strong sense of admiration for the strength of the pro-life movement, which I clearly saw in the thousands of people witnessing to the human rights of the pre-born. If I'm honest with myself, though, I also felt like this was a "pro-life checkbox," an event in which I had to participate simply to call myself a pro-lifer.

That conviction to do something about the tragedy of abortion fizzled out after I returned to my day-to-day life. No longer surrounded by the passion of thousands of people, it was easy to forget and ignore the reality of abortion.

This year, I experienced a deeper interior stirring that this demonstration to protect the human rights of the pre-born could not simply be a one-time, once-a-year experience. I owe that to serving this mission with DCRTL.

Since daily committing to this cause, I've encountered the weight and tragedy of abortion more personally than ever before. Whether it's talking to a pro-choice person in outreach or hearing real, personal stories of children killed through abortion, I have become more and more aware of the gravity of this issue – and my responsibility to respond.

We're not supposed to simply march for one day out of the year. This is the greatest injustice of our time, and it demands more than just the belief that abortion is wrong. We must "march" year-round by taking concrete action to confront this evil until it's unthinkable.

That's why we continue to march even now that Roe has been overturned, leaving the decision to make abortion legal or illegal to the states' representatives. This victory for Life does not mean we can go home and consider the battle against abortion won. Instead, it must energize us to work for cultural change. Until our culture can see and believe that abortion is a horror – a human rights violation against the most vulnerable – our work is not done.

I'm grateful for the opportunity to march with so many passionate pro-life advocates this year. I'm grateful for the gift of Life, and the opportunity to celebrate that Life every day, with a community that spans the nation. And I'm grateful to be part of this mission to end abortion.

Let's continue our march this year to not only be a voice for the voiceless, but also to work for a day when abortion is rejected as the true human injustice that it is.

About our Keynote Speaker: Mayra Rodriguez, Former Planned Parenthood Director



Mayra Rodriguez is the former director of the largest Planned Parenthood clinic in Arizona. She worked for Planned Parenthood for 17 years, managing several affiliates and receiving the Employee of the Year award in 2016. She felt she was living the American Dream, until she began to notice and report instances of critical safety and health-related violations including incomplete abortions, falsification of patient records, illegal conduct, unreported statutory rape, severe injuries by abortion and high complication rates with a specific abortionist. She was fired in October 2017, after which she filed a wrongful termination lawsuit. In August of 2019, a jury of her peers unanimously awarded her \$3 million in damages done by Planned Parenthood.

Come hear her share her story of going from one of abortion's strongest supporters to a pro-life advocate, defending the lives of vulnerable pre-born children.

2026 SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST

Attention all graduating high school seniors! Our annual scholarship contest for 2026 is upon us. This is an opportunity for you to express your pro-life views to compete for a scholarship for college. See below for more details!

Who: Graduating high school seniors who plan to attend college

Scholarship Amount: Up to \$10,000 is available to be awarded between applicants at the discretion of the judging committee

Expectations: Students must submit a written copy of an original speech (5-10 minutes in length) on the topic “Unpacking the Gift of Life When it is Most Challenging.” Students must also submit evidence of service hours logged in the cause of protecting human life. They must also submit one (1) recommendation letter describing individual commitment to some aspect of the DCRTL mission.

About the Topic: We firmly believe that Life — all Life — is a gift that should be celebrated, cherished, and protected in every stage and in every circumstance. It’s easy to see Life as a gift when those circumstances are going well, when they are filled with joy and happy memories. But what about when life is challenging or involves suffering? Students are encouraged to reflect on how life is still a gift, even when the beginning, middle, or end of that life is challenging. We encourage students to consider how we treat people with special needs, elderly patients nearing the end of life, or other circumstances the abortion industry often uses to justify abortion.

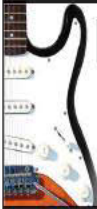
