About our Keynote Speaker: Mayra Rodriguez, Former Planned Parenthood Director

Mayra Rodriguez is the former director of the largest Planned Parenthood clinic in Arizona. She worked for Planned Parenthood for 17 years, managing several affiliates and receiving the Employee of the Year award in 2016. She felt she was living the American Dream, until she began to notice and report instances of critical safety and health-related violations including incomplete abortions, falsification of patient records, illegal conduct, unreported statutory rape, severe injuries by abortion and high complication rates with a specific abortionist. She was fired in October 2017, after which she filed a wrongful termination lawsuit. In August of 2019, a jury of her peers unanimously awarded her \$3 million in damages done by Planned Parenthood.

Come hear her share her story of going from one of abortion's strongest supporters to a pro-life advocate, defending the lives of vulnerable pre-born children.

Every Thursday morning, Arthur Gilloon and other DCRTL members carpool down to Iowa City to pray and offer life-affirming options to the mothers entering Emma Goldman abortion facility. A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.'s "Letter from Birmingham Jail" was written in response to people who preferred waiting over direct action, even as Black Americans were suffering under segregation and unjust laws. In that letter, he reminds us of two truths that speak to our own movement: injustice is here, and time is neutral.

"Injustice is here."

I read the phrase "injustice is here," and I immediately thought of our community. How many people believe that the injustice of abortion still exists in our community? Do we, deep down, believe that injustice is present in our community?

Planned Parenthood in Dubuque was shut down due to your prayers and efforts. With Planned Parenthood no longer having a visible presence in Dubuque, it can be easy to forget that the injustice of abortion is still present in our community. I wish it weren't the case and that having an abortion was unthinkable.

Today, the most common abortion method (the abortion pill) can be completed at home and even obtained in the mail. The abortion pill starves the child to death by withholding progesterone (the baby's nutrients). Outside of the abortion pill being completed at home, mothers can travel to Iowa City to have a surgical abortion, or even to Illinois for a late-term abortion; both options are easily accessible and affect people in our community.

Injustice is here in the United States. Injustice is here in Iowa. Injustice is happening here in Dubuque.

Time is neutral

Later in the letter, King writes that time is neutral. That injustice coming to an end is not inevitable. It takes the effort and courage of good people to use time to bring the injustice to an end. It doesn't just happen.

Thank you to those who have been part of this battle to end this atrocity in our area, whether you joined us as a member recently or have been a member for decades; you're taking an active role in making abortion unthinkable in our area.

Knowing that abortion is still happening in our community, that people believe taking the life of the child should be legal and, in some circumstances, even encouraged, this injustice will not just go away with the passage of time.

We need outreach, practical support for mothers, prayer, and education happening in our community, just like it was when Planned Parenthood had its abortion facility here. Let us press on, as the social reformers did in the past, to use our time and resources to end injustice.

PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

Dear Friends for LIFE—

Let's focus on Iowa first. As I mentioned last month, lots going on with several pro-life bills being proposed in the Iowa Legislature. By the time you read this column, we'll know the likely fate of the black market abortion pill bill (House File 2523) and the maternity home donation tax credit bill (Senate File 2279). See last month's newsletter for the specifics of these bills and how they could advance the pro-life movement in Iowa. Then keep your eyes open for an email update or call the office at 556-5960 to check on their status. Based on that, you can decide whether you are moved to contact your legislator.

Now, some dismal news from Indiana. We've known since *Dobbs* overruled *Roe v. Wade* that pro-death forces were planning lawsuits claiming that the right to abortion is a constitutional right based on freedom of religion. Well, they recently convinced an Indiana state court judge of just that. The ACLU of Indiana filed a class action lawsuit in 2022 on behalf of a group called "Hoosier Jews for Choice," and other plaintiffs the Court has allowed to remain anonymous. It took 3 years for the case to work its way through the courts, but on March 5, 2026, Indiana State Court Judge Christina Klineman issued a permit injunction in favor of the ACLU's clients. The judge's order blocks enforcement of Indiana's pro-life law against anyone who wants to kill their unborn child based on a religious belief. As crazy as this sounds, one of the plaintiffs suing claimed that although she was not a member of any particular religious tradition, she held "spiritual and religious beliefs" about autonomy and the beginning of life that would require her to have an abortion under certain circumstances, such as when the "birth of another child would not allow her to fully realize her humanity, and inherent dignity." Can you believe that!? This is a bizarre and devilish argument. Likewise, the judge's ruling is a macabre and insane twisting of laws passed to protect religious freedom...not to justify killing babies and harming women. Fortunately, the Attorney General of the State of Indiana is appealing the ruling, and it may end up before the Supreme Court of the United States at some point.

Let me close this month's column with some happy international news. On March 17, 2026, the Scottish Parliament rejected a law that would've made Scotland the first member of the United Kingdom to legalize physician-assisted suicide. The United Kingdom is comprised of England, Wales, Northern Ireland, and Scotland. While this vote is not a precedent that the other three UK countries are required to follow, it sends a clear pro-life message to those countries. This is because the bill was debated in Scotland for two years while pro-life advocates battled it out with the pro-death forces. Fortunately, many Scottish physicians and disability rights groups rallied against the bill, which undoubtedly turned the tide of public opinion against the killing this law would have allowed.

Well, that's it for Iowa news this month. Please stay informed and voice your opinion whenever and as often as you can. Dubuque County Right To Life, Inc. will help you do just that by giving you the facts.

Reflection on a Year with DCRTL

One year ago, on a warm, sunny April day, I packed my belongings into a U-haul moving van, said goodbye to my younger siblings, and set out for Dubuque, Iowa, to a new city, a new apartment, and a new job.

Along with the nervous expectations and excitement for this very new and uncertain adventure, I brought with me a desire to answer one question: “What can I do for the pre-born?” There was a strong conviction that simply believing abortion is wrong was not enough anymore. God opened a door to this mission -- to advocate for His little ones with the gifts and talents He’s given me.

Reflecting on this past year, I’m beyond humbled and grateful God has brought me to DCRTL for His purpose. I am grateful to you, our supporters, for making this mission possible with your generosity. While I pray God continues to use me to make an impact for the pre-born, I truly believe He’s used this mission to transform me--permanently--as well.

Deepening Convictions

The belief that pre-born children possess an inherent dignity given to them by God is one that I’ve held for as long as I could remember. There was no doubt or question in my mind that abortion was a grave violation of their dignity because it took their lives.

Living and working for that conviction though has only served to deepen and strengthen it. Now I’ve seen the images of the little babies destroyed by abortion. Different research projects have brought me face to face with the deception, lies, and disgusting practices of the abortion industry. Hearing people’s stories in outreach has softened my heart to those who are simply thirsting for compassion and truth.

These experiences have changed my own heart to realize that abortion is not simply an injustice I cannot support, but an evil that I have an obligation to fight.

Encountering Real People With Real Stories

When I first came to interview for DCRTL, I had the opportunity to also shadow an outreach on UW-Platteville’s campus. I found myself in a conversation with a student who was adamantly pro-choice. At the time, I didn’t have the training or answers to explain the pro-life position.

All I could do was listen to her -- to her concerns, her arguments, her personal stories.

Because of working with DCRTL, I know that listening is the best foundation we can build in conversations like these. I also have the skills to share the truth with empathy. I’ve witnessed people change their minds and hearts on abortion and recognize it for the evil that it is.

Defending the pre-born has taught me that change happens when I step outside my comfort zone. Nothing will ever be more rewarding or transformative than changing culture by encountering people on a personal level.

Blessings & Gratitude

Working for DCRTL has been a tremendous blessing in my life. I went from being fearful to say I’m pro-life to having confidence in my convictions and boldness in sharing them with others. I’ve joined an incredible community of other pro-life advocates who continue to inspire me to stay committed to this mission. Thank you for your constant support, which has given me this opportunity to defend the pre-born.

The stories people have shared with me during outreach have changed my own heart to regard people with more compassion and more empathy.

Seeing the injustice of abortion has convicted me that nothing is more pressing and more necessary than standing up for the pre-born -- the countless little boys and girls who don’t have a voice to stand up for themselves.

A year ago, I wanted to know how I could make a difference for the pre-born. Today, I realize that the only thing I can’t do is nothing. This past year has convinced me that until this horrific injustice ends, I will never stop serving this mission with intentionality, boldness, and compassion.

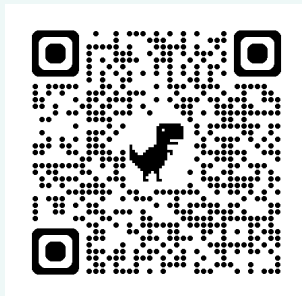
We're Hiring! - Program & Operations Associate (Full-Time)
