Life Defender Bootcamp July 16th - 18th Cedar Rapids, IA

Dubuque County Right to Life is excited to announce a new, three-day pro-life bootcamp that combines pro-life apologetics training with conversational outreach to change hearts on abortion. This experience is open to 16-24 year olds who desire to make an impact for the pre-born.

A NOTE FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Dear Pro-Life Friends,

A warm welcome to our newest members who are reading this for the first time!

Mayra Rodriguez, our LIFE Dinner speaker, was personally opposed to abortion, but she worked for Planned Parenthood. Her belief was that she herself wouldn't get an abortion, but who is she to tell someone else what they can or can't do with their body?

We may know people who hold this belief and understand where they are coming from, while others' response might be similar to Vizzini's in the movie *The Princess Bride* – “inconceivable.”

How could someone think that?

Most of the people I come across who hold this belief believe that their opposition to abortion is ONLY rooted in a religious belief or a personal family belief, and that it would be wrong for the government to have this requirement on its citizens because it is a religious belief or the belief of some people.

In their defense, there are many examples of religious or family beliefs that should not be legislated.

Many people who hold this belief don't know why their religious denomination is against abortion, or they have never heard a strong non-religious argument against abortion.

Through a third-party poll, we learned that 21% of people in Dubuque County identify as being personally opposed but that abortion should remain legal.

Our goal with outreach this summer is to reduce the number of those who are personally opposed but still think abortion should be legal.

We have so much that we agree on (common ground) with this group of people because they are already against abortion to a certain degree and believe that it is a bad thing. It's in the gap that we must show them that abortion is a human rights violation and must be banned.

It's through your support that people in our community will be reached with the truth, and hearts and minds will change through digital messaging and the many conversations that will be had.

Thank you to all who came to the LIFE Dinner and to everyone who gave or pledged sacrificially!!! With your generosity, we have reached \$198,451.75 in gifts and pledges toward our \$300,000 goal, and generous gifts are still coming in. PRO-LIFE LEGISLATIVE, COURT, AND OTHER LEGAL NEWS

IOWA NEWS

As this column went to print, the Tax Credit for Maternity Homes Contributions bill was still alive. This bill would give a tax credit of up to \$5,000.00 for monetary gifts to places like Mary's Inn in Dubuque. In the Iowa Senate, it was known as SF 2495.

In the House of the Iowa Legislature, House File 2563 was also alive. This bill would make it illegal to peddle abortion pills through the mail in Iowa, force abortionists to tell women that the process is still reversible after the first pill is taken, and tell them of the dangers of the at-home abortion pill killing procedure.

The 2026 Iowa Legislative session will likely be over by the time you read this, so call our office to see what happened to these proposed laws in this year's legislative session (563-556-5960).

International News with Midwest/U.S. connection

This column in recent newsletters noted the new Illinois Medical Aid in Dying Law (i.e., MAID law) that allows doctors to write a killing prescription for a patient who wants to die by suicide. I've also written about similar laws in a dozen other U.S. states and around the world. It is known that these laws are being abused by applying them to patients with brain health issues, the disabled, and those who cannot speak for themselves. We must educate on this topic as much as possible because these laws are proposed in Iowa every year. In many parts of the world, they are also being used on minors. The Netherlands (i.e., 12 provinces including Holland) provides a recent chilling example of this type of abuse.

According to the Dutch Regional Euthanasia Review Committee Report published March 2025, a 17-year-old autistic young man was injected with killing drugs at his request. This child also had anxiety, depression, and mood related problems. He reported constant, suicidal thoughts. Two years before his death, he made a serious suicide attempt. For over a decade, he received psychoeducation, cognitive behavioral therapy, and medication. That all sounds appropriate, doesn't it?

However, this child always lived at home with only his parents and was never given what his doctors referred to as "intensive intervention," i.e., admission to a psychiatric hospital or referral to a center with autism experience. The doctors who eventually killed him claimed hospitalization was not called for because "that would mean having to leave his familiar surroundings, and becoming unsettled." Moreover, a certain type of antidepressant (tricyclic) had not yet been tried for this child's mood-related problems. Neither had other treatments commonly used in anti-depression protocol been tried, such as electroconvulsive therapy (ECT) and ketamine. Nonetheless, this young person's doctors ruled that he should be allowed to kill himself with their help, despite never having been treated with a drug known to treat depression or having the benefit of inpatient treatment in the hospital. They determined he had a "terminal mental illness." So he was killed.

What happened to this boy was totally inappropriate, wrong, and immoral. These doctors gave up on this young man who needed their help.

Unless we stop this pro-suicide movement and educate on the dangers of so-called medical aid in dying laws, this is the future of the MAID law in Illinois and elsewhere. They start with convincing elderly and infirm people that suicide is best and move onto the disabled and young people who have brain health issues.

It's no secret that our culture and society today seem intent on devaluing the dignity of motherhood and the profound role it plays in families and children's lives. She gave me my education and formation as she dedicated countless hours to homeschooling us. Every day, my mom reveals to me the opposite of what society tries to tell women: that being a mother is the most noble calling and role that women can embrace. Not because it's easy. Not because it always makes sense or goes smoothly. But because it's a mother's love and sacrifice that reveals to her child their inherent worth and dignity.

I'm not sure where I'd be without my own mom. Her influence on who I am today cannot be understated. She's walked unwaveringly with me through every struggle, suffering, and triumph I've experienced in my own life, and I'll never outgrow needing her support.

This Mother's Day is a reminder for me to thank her and honor her for all she has given and poured out into my life. It's also a reminder that, as I continue to fight for the value and dignity of the pre-born, one powerful element is to remind women that they are a gift to their children.

Our culture lies to women about motherhood. It tells women that motherhood hinders their career or becomes a stumbling block to pursuing their goals. Or worse, it demeans women by convincing them they can't raise a child while in school or working.

Let's commit to telling women the truth about their motherhood -- that their capacity to love and form their children is profound, beautiful, and irreplaceable.

Thank you to all the mothers (or mother figures) in our own lives who've made such an impact in our lives. I hope you know how much YOU are loved this Mother's Day.

Walking in Purpose: A Year of Reflection ~ Molly Strohmeyer

After a year now of working for Dubuque County Right to Life full-time, I have been blessed with so many wonderful opportunities and experiences I never thought I would have! Just thinking back to last summer when I took on a whole new role of conducting outreach, I feel as though I have come so far in not only being able to explain my pro-life beliefs to others, but to also have confidence and compassion in doing so.

Last summer, Protect Life Michigan (PLM) offered our team to join them in their internship so we could gain experience and learn their training approaches. Before going into this, I was very nervous. I used to be shy and did not want to talk about my controversial views—very much the life of a “people-pleaser.” With also being a little more introverted than others, I thought this new role was going to be tiresome and difficult. And sure, the training was nerve-wracking at first. But it was worth it. I got the chance to talk to so many people and learn about their personal stories. I got to share the pro-life message with some who have not even heard of it before.

On one of the training days, we learned of the tragedy of the DC-Five, which were 5 babies killed in late-term abortions at the Washington D.C. Surgi-Clinic. Now, I knew I was pro-life, and I knew that abortion was wrong. PLM showed a video by Progressive Anti-Abortion Uprising (PAAU) that revealed the true violence of abortion to me in a way I have never seen before. During sidewalk counseling at the clinic one day, they recovered a box of 115 aborted babies. One hundred-and fifteen human lives taken before they even began. Five of which were nearly full-term. It broke my heart. It convicted me in a way that I had never felt before. It made me want to do more because how could something so wicked like this exist? Our laws are meant to protect the innocent and vulnerable, not destroy them.

After that first glimpse into the violence of abortion, it changed me. I gained confidence in outreach because I knew what I was doing was greater than myself. It was for the little lives of those who never got a chance to live them. It was for the women who were taken advantage of and convinced that what they were doing was “healthcare.” It was for the value and dignity of all human life.

After a year of working at Dubuque County Right to Life, I feel incredibly grateful and blessed to call this my job. One of my favorite things to see is how we are educating the youth in the Dubuque Community and surrounding areas. From our 5th-Grade poster contest, meaningful outreach at summer camp and the county fair, dialogue and discussion in high schools, our monthly high school Ambassadors for Life meetings, and conducting outreach at local colleges: all these amazing programs are helping to build a culture that celebrates LIFE! It brings me joy to know the work I do could potentially save a life, and it is all because of our generous supporters. Without mission partners like YOU, none of this would be possible. So, thank you for being the strength and powerhouse of this wonderful organization. I can’t wait to see what the future holds for DCRTL and the Dubuque community!
